

INFORMATION ON FEES 2026–2027 (subject to confirmation)



The total cost consists of three elements :

1. Registration fee (**DI**) → amount payable to the Wallonia-Brussels Federation.
2. Specific registration fee (**DIS**) → amount payable to the Wallonia-Brussels Federation.
3. Enrolment fees (**FI**) → €20 administrative fee per academic year + contribution to the non-profit organization's operating costs.

How is the total cost calculated?

The total cost is calculated by adding the registration fee, the enrolment fees (FI), and, in some cases, the specific registration fee (DIS).

DI (REGISTRATION FEE):

Since the 2013–2014 academic year, registration fees for one academic year are calculated based on the total number of course periods that give rise to remuneration for teaching staff, as specified in the pedagogical files of the training units in which a student enrolls and whose first tenth of duration falls within the said academic year, regardless of whether all periods are actually taught during that academic year.

- In secondary education for social promotion: a flat rate of €34 per student for the academic year.

- In secondary education: €0.30 per course period, including supervision hours, of 50 minutes up to the 800th period.

DIS (SPECIFIC REGISTRATION FEE):

A student of foreign nationality (outside the European Union) who has reached the age of 18 on the date(s) of the first tenth of the unit(s) in which they are enrolled, or at the time of enrollment if it occurs after this first tenth, is in principle required to pay a DIS.
